

In 2022, inspired by Dr. Fred Busch's book *Dear Candidate* (and thanks to his continual guidance and mentorship – he even wrote a foreword for the book!), 40 psychoanalysts-in-training spanning 29 different countries and all 6 inhabitable continents set off to write a book with the goal of shedding light on the state of contemporary psychoanalysis – its training, practice and relevance. Each chapter has been written in the style of personal letters from candidates to their faculty and institutes. The authors include a candidate from the Institut psychanalytique de Montréal and a recent graduate from the Western Canada Psychoanalytic Society and Institute. Each contributor shares a piece of their mind – and their heart – about the trials and tribulations of the process of psychoanalytic training – what they cherished, what they loathed, why they spoke up and why they thought about dropping out.
